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1) Mail this completed form to VT Volunteer Services for Animals Humane Society (VWSA), PO Box 100, Bridgewater, VT 05034 with a check for \$13 per animal. If your form doesn't arrive by Wednesday, March 17th, you'll have to pay cash at the clinic. THIS WILL SAVE VALUABLE TIME! HOWEVER:

2) You can send this form via email: skaskiw@vermontel.net. Transcribe ALL needed information and email no later than Wednesday, March 17th. Exact cash will be collected at the clinic if the paperwork is received by email in time. If either isn't possible, fill out the form **OR** transcribe all information onto a piece of paper and bring with you with the exact cash. This will save some time.

3) People are welcome to show up that day and fill out the paperwork while in line.

The "DRIVE UP & POKE! RABIES CLINIC" is Saturday March 20th, 12-2:00 in the parking lot of the Woodstock Union High School. A single line of cars will be formed. People & animals stay in the car. The VT Spay Neuter Incentive Program (VSNIP) applications will be available (or send a SASE to VSNIP, PO Box 104, Bridgewater, VT 05034) to apply to help neuter your cat/dog. Funded only by a \$4.00 fee when licensing dogs, VSNIP is under the VT Economic Services. If eligible, the cost to you is \$27.00.
