If your form doesn't arrive by Wednesday, March 24th, you'll have to pay cash at the clinic. **PREREGISTERING WILL SAVE VALUABLE TIME!** HOWEVER:
- 2) You can send this form via email: skaskiw@vermontel.net. with ALL needed information and email no later than Wednesday, March 24th. Exact cash will be collected at the clinic if the paperwork is received by email in time. If either isn't possible, fill out the form **OR** transcribe all information onto a piece of paper and bring with you with the exact cash. This will save some time.

The VT Spay Neuter Incentive Program (VSNIP) applications will be available (or send a SASE to VSNIP, PO Box 104, Bridgewater, VT 05034) to apply to help neuter your cat/dog. Funded only by a \$4.00 fee when licensing dogs, VSNIP is under the VT Economic Services. If eligible, the cost to you is \$27.00. ALL DOGS MUST BE LICENSED AFTER BEING VACCINATED.
